I'm your host, (host name). Today I'm pleased to have Cam 3 - MCU Host (Guest's first and last name) in the studio with us. , thanks for being with us today. Cam 2 – 2 shot Guest & host exchange pleasantries. HOST (Q1): Tell us a little bit about yourself. Cam 3 – MCU Host What do you like to study or do here at IU? **GUEST**: (answers) Cam 1- MCU Guest Host and guest can improvise for a minute or so. Director should use all cameras Cam 3 - MCU Host **HOST (Q2):** I understand you've brought something with you today. Can you tell us about it? Cam 1 - MCU Guest / object **GUEST:** (Shows object & answers) **SNEAK MUSIC** (in at 3:30) Cam 2 – 2 shot HOST: Unfortunately it looks like we've run out of time. We've been talking with (guest name). Thanks so much for being with us today. Cam 3 – MCU Host Tune in next time for another edition of Studio 5 Profiles. Until then, I'm (host name) thanks for watching. Cam 2- Cover shot **MUSIC UP FULL** DISSOLVE to GRAPHIC -"Studio 5 Profile"

FADE OUT

Studio 5 Profile - Production notes:

- Segment should run exactly 4 minutes long. (Not including countdown).
- The Floor Director should be positioned near Camera 3 (or wherever the Host camera is)
- The Director should be prepared for whatever the object is that the guest brings in. (For instance be prepared if it's a picture to zoom in on, or something where the guest might need more room than a MCU.
- The host will have to improvise some with the guest. He/she should have some questions prepared to fill the time. Sample questions might include:
 - O What do you like to do outside of class?
 - o How did you get interested in _____?
 - o Do you have any upcoming plans for break
 - o What's your favorite part about being here at IU?
- The AD should start the timer when the countdown clock hits 0.
- The Host and Guest should be talking to each other when the show opens, before the Floor Director cues them.
- The director should remember to MIC and CUE the HOST at the proper time.
- The AD should also help the director remember to bring in the music at 3:30 in.
- The director should be prepared to have the FD WIND UP, STRETCH, SPEED UP or CUT.
- After the talent says good-bye, the director should remember to have the audio engineer CUT MICS.
