Lab rotation structure:

During setup (40-50 minutes):

- Group 1 designs set & lighting and runs cameras (You will be graded on this)
- Group 2 helps build set, set lights & set cameras
- Group 3 sets up audio (You will be graded on this)
- Group 4 gets a CG / Chyron lesson. Prepare slate, title graphic and lower third(s)

During production (2-3 rotations, 5 minutes each):

- Group 1 rotates (optional) as camera operators & FD
- Group 2 rotates as host, guests and producer (The host selects the topic)
- Group 3 rotates through audio, tape operator & announcer
- Group 4 rotates through as CG, TD, AD & DIR

After the first set of rotations: Group 1 swaps with 4. Group 2 swaps with 3. (During week two, students will swap into the next two sets of groups.)

Rubric (20 points total):

- Topic and talent duties 4 points
- Lighting/set design 8 points
- Audio engineering duties 8 points
